Name for the Promised One:

The Great Announcement, Illustrious Messenger

81 When Allah made (His) covenant with the prophets, (He said): Behold that which I have given you of the Scripture and knowledge. And afterward there will come unto you a messenger, confirming that which ye possess. Ye shall believe in him and ye shall help him. He said: Do ye agree, and will ye take up My burden (which I lay upon you) in this (matter) ? They answered: We agree. He said: Then bear ye witness. I will be a witness with you. Name for the Promised One:

Vishnu Yasha (Sanskrit for) Glory of God.

Name for the Promised One:”

Glory of God, Glory of the Lord, The Blessed Beauty, etc.

These refer to Baha’u’llah (Persian for the Glory Of God) himself.
